Weekly Questions

DAY 1: Mark 14-34

A disciple was a student who "left everything" to follow their teacher, memorizing his words, mimicking his actions and eventually stepping right into his ministry. What has following Jesus caused you to leave behind? How have you stepped right into His ministry? Pray. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you any steps you need to take in following Jesus.

DAY 2: Matthew 10

After 2 years of watching Jesus do ministry, Jesus finally sends the disciples out to do the ministry themselves. He gave them a broad definition for "saving lives." He didn't send them to just get people to "pray a prayer of salvation." How can you better engage in Jesus' bigger definition of "saving lives?" Pray. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you who in your life He would like you to pursue with His saving love.

DAY 3: Hebrews 6:1-12

Strong words! Here we clearly see that disciples are called to maturity. Disciples grow on the path from infancy to adolescence to parenthood. Believer to follower to servant. Where do you find yourself on this path? Have you taken personal initiative for your own growth along the path? Pray. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you mature (and what you should do to help).

DAY 4: Romans 5:1-5

Read this slowly a few times. Notice that long-term perseverance as a disciple produces Christ-like character. Did you know that one of God's goals for you is to lovingly reform your character? Where has God already reformed aspects of your character? Where is He at work right now? Pray. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you. Thank the Father for what He has given you!
